"By consensus, it is the opinion of this committee that this installation would not be approved. 1002.1 states that each plumbing fixture shall be trapped. 901.2.1 states that every trap and trapped fixture must be vented. Sec. 712.1 states that the min. trap size for laundry tray $1\frac{1}{2}$ "
